Pursuant to Section 1901.14(A)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Berea Municipal Court herewith submits its 49th Annual Report for the year 2007. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Raymond J. Wohl, the Clerk of Court and his staff of Deputy Clerks. This report reflects the financial and statistical activity of the Court in detail with respect to all political subdivisions within the Court district.

The Berea Municipal Court has been located in the City of Berea, by an act of the Ohio Legislature, since 1958. The Court district boundaries cover an area of 60.8 square miles and has a total population of 118,125 (per 2000 U.S. Census).

The Court serves the cities of Berea, Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, Olmsted Falls, Olmsted Township, Strongsville, in addition to the Ohio Turnpike (Ohio State Patrol) in Strongsville, Berea, and Olmsted Township; Interstate 71 (Ohio State Patrol) in Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, and Strongsville; and the Cleveland Metropolitan Park System within the Berea Municipal Court's boundaries.

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

It is with great pleasure that we present to you the 2007 Berea Municipal Court Annual Report.

Highlights

2007 was a transitional year for the Berea Municipal Court. The Civil Department saw an increase of over 15% in new filings compared to calendar year 2006. Our Traffic/Criminal Department, again, saw an overall decrease in new filings. The decrease in new filings was evident in all but two cities within our jurisdiction.

During 2007 the Berea Municipal Court received over \$91,000 in waiver payments through the use of the Court website. The availability of this resource provides convenience to violators saving a trip to Court to make a payment in person with a total of approximately 2,000 citations having been paid online since inception. In addition, our website had over 100,000 visits in 2007 with over 1.9 million pages being accessed in those visits.

As in the past, the Court on the Road initiative was continued at Strongsville High School with the government classes observing live Court as it was conducted in the school auditorium. This allows the students the opportunity to observe actual cases being heard in the Berea Municipal Court and affords students the opportunity to interact with the Judge and Clerk of Courts during a question and answer period.

Our economy continues to have a negative impact on our ability to collect fines and costs. In 2007 we directed outstanding fines and costs of over \$390,000 to our outside collection firm, Capital Recovery Systems. This amount was turned over

despite our efforts to collect, which include warrants for non appearance, blockage of drivers license renewals and license plate renewals. Since Capital Recovery was retained, we have assigned approximately \$1.5 million dollars to them for collection. Over \$500,000 has been collected without cost to this Court or the taxpayers of our district. In addition, money owing hearings are being held on a bi-weekly basis with approximately 160 cases being heard in a day to attempt to collect these outstanding fines and costs. Additionally, the Court processed 534 garnishments and 667 bank attachments related to civil judgments.

We continue working in an obsolete facility without proper space requirements, courtrooms and security. As always, we are concerned about the safety of our employees, defendants and individuals using the Court on a daily basis. It has gotten to the point that the current facility is having a negative impact on the courts ability to conduct business in a legal, safe and confident manner that the public deserves. We look forward to working with the new administration to resolve these issues.

A heartfelt thank you to the entire staff including our Acting Judges, Magistrates, staff of the Traffic/Criminal Division, Civil Division, Probation and Bailiffs, for the outstanding job they provided in 2007. Our staff of Deputy Clerks are truly professionals and complete their work in an efficient and business-like manner, and are ever mindful of the people we serve. We would like to acknowledge the passing of John Grech, Sr., a volunteer bailiff for the past 3 years. His presence and smiling face in the Courtroom will be missed.

In closing, thank you to Mayor Joseph W. Biddlecombe, his directors, staff and Berea City Council, Police Chief Mark Schultz and his officers for their support. We appreciate your kindness, the confidence you have in us and your cooperation with us in the administration of the Berea Municipal Court.

In conclusion, you can rest assured that we will continue to monitor and evaluate the operations and expenses of the Court and to ensure that that the Berea Municipal Court is operated in a fiscally responsible and business-like manner.

SECTION FIVE PROBATION

2007 COMMUNITY CONTROL SANCTIONS REPORT

At the beginning of 2007, the Community Control Department had a staff of 3 full time employees and 2 part-time employees. By the end of the year, the staff had been reduced to 2 full time employees and 2 part-time employees. The department continues to utilize non-paid part time interns. The interns are obtained from local colleges such as Baldwin Wallace, ITT, and Bryant and Stratton and the students are often majoring in Psychology and/or Criminal Justice.

The Community Control Officers supervised, as directed by the Court approximately 2,139 defendants during 2007. Approximately 1,300 of those defendants were drug and/or alcohol offenses and 386 were for domestic violence and other violent offenses. Approximately 325 defendants were supervised for theft and other property related offenses.

At the direction of the Judge, the Community Control Department continues to utilize many social service agencies and support groups within the community and is continually adding more resources for the defendant. In addition to Alcoholics Anonymous meetings, the Department has also incorporated Narcotics Anonymous, Emotions Anonymous, Gambler's Anonymous and Recovery, Inc. programs based on the needs of each defendant.

The Driving Under Suspension (DUES) diversion program continues to grow each year. This year approximately 150 defendants reinstated their license with help of the program. The First Offender Diversion Program also saw an increase in referrals with approximately 63 defendants taking advantage of the opportunity to amend their behavior and avoid having a criminal conviction on their record.

The Berea Municipal Court continues to be one of the locations for the Mother's Against Drunk Driving (MADD) Driver Awareness Sessions. These sessions include five tiers that cover various topics such as alcohol education and victim and family impact. The cost of the program is \$25.00 for each tier and the proceeds go directly to MADD to assist victims of alcohol related driving offenses.
