Pursuant to Section 1901.14(A)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Berea Municipal Court herewith submits its 53rd Annual Report for the year 2011. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Raymond J. Wohl, the Clerk of Courts and his staff of Deputy Clerks. This report reflects the financial and statistical activity of the Court in detail with respect to all political subdivisions within the Court district.

The Berea Municipal Court has been located in the City of Berea, by an act of the Ohio Legislature, since 1958. The Court district boundaries cover an area of 60.8 square miles and have a total population of 121,538 (per 2010 U.S. Census).

The Court serves the cities of Berea, Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, Olmsted Falls, Olmsted Township, Strongsville, in addition to the Ohio Turnpike (Ohio State Patrol) in Strongsville, Berea, and Olmsted Township; Interstate 71 (Ohio State Patrol) in Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, and Strongsville; and the Cleveland Metropolitan Park System within the Berea Municipal Court's boundaries.

It is with great pleasure that we present to you the 2011 Berea Municipal Court Annual Report which is the 53rd such Annual Report.

Highlights

2011 was a year that again reflected the state of the local and national economy in our Civil Department. Although we saw a slight decrease in the number of new cases filed in our Civil Department, collection actions on outstanding judgments increased by 8.1% compared to 2010. Our Traffic/Criminal Department results showed an 8.5% decrease in new filings compared to 2010.

Our economy continues to have a negative impact on our ability to collect fines and costs. In 2011 we continued a semi-monthly hearing schedule specifically for defendants with outstanding fines and costs. The purpose of these hearings is to allow for regular payments to be made, thereby avoiding more serious legal ramifications.

The Clerk of Courts staff continued and improved efforts with the scanning of closed civil cases. This effort eliminated the cost of storage for these files. The program includes the destruction of these files after careful verification of all scanned documents and enhances the Clerk of Courts office efficiency for document retrieval.

In 2011 the Cuyahoga County Sheriff, under the guidance of Sheriff Bob Reid, began traffic enforcement within our Court District resulting in over 350 new cases being brought to the Court. We appreciate this effort and look forward to a cooperative working arrangement with the Sheriff and his deputies.

During 2011 the Berea Municipal Court received \$93,000 for 575 waiver payments through the use of the Court website. The availability of this resource continues to provide convenience to violators by saving the trip to Court to make a payment in person.

As in the past, the Court on the Road initiative was continued this year at Strongsville High School with the Junior and Senior class government students observing live Court as it was conducted in the school auditorium. This allows the students the opportunity to observe actual cases heard by the Berea Municipal Court and affords them the opportunity to interact with the Judge and Clerk of Courts during a question and answer period. During this exchange the perils of making "wrong choices" is highlighted for the benefit of all students.

We would like to extend a sincere thank you to the entire staff including our Acting Judges, Magistrates, Traffic/Criminal Division, Civil Division, Probation and Bailiffs for the outstanding service they provided in 2011. Our staff of Deputy Clerks is truly professional and completes their work in an efficient and business-like manner and is ever mindful of the people we serve.

Thank you to Mayor Cyril Kleem, his directors, staff and Berea City Council, Police Chief Mark Schultz and his officers for their support. We appreciate the confidence you have in us and your cooperation with us in the administration of the Berea Municipal Court.

In conclusion, you can rest assured that we will continue to monitor and evaluate the operations and expenses of the Court so that the Berea Municipal Court is operated in a fiscally responsible and business-like manner.

SECTION FIVE COMMUNITY CONTROL

2011 COMMUNITY CONTROL DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

The Berea Municipal Court Community Control Department provides a variety of services to the court and the defendants. As directed by the Judge, the Community Control Department provides pre-sentence investigation reports consisting of interviews with defendants, victims, police reports, and any additional information regarding the incident as available. The reports are used by the court to determine the appropriate sentence to minimize the recidivism of the defendants. The Community Control Department monitors defendants' compliance with the court's conditions of sentence as well as defendants referred into the court's Diversion Programs. The court currently has a DUS Diversion program that assists defendants in obtaining a valid driver's license and a First Offender program that works with low risk, non-violent, first time offenders. The program requirements for each defendant are based on the nature of the offense and are tailored to educate each participant on the effects of their actions and to prevent the defendant from re-offending.

In addition to the courts staff two students from local colleges completed an internship at the court assisting the community control officers in daily tasks.

Indigent Drivers Alcohol Treatment Fund (IDAT):

The IDAT fund provides treatment and monitoring services for persons arrested for OVI offenses that are unable to afford these services. The IDAT fund operates on the State fiscal year, with the funds coming from fees and fines collected as set per Ohio legislation.
