Pursuant to Section 1901.14(A)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Berea Municipal Court herewith submits its 54<sup>th</sup> Annual Report for the year 2012. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Raymond J. Wohl, the Clerk of Courts and his staff of Deputy Clerks. This report reflects the financial and statistical activity of the Court in detail with respect to all political subdivisions within the Court district.

The Berea Municipal Court has been located in the City of Berea, by an act of the Ohio Legislature, since 1958. The Court district boundaries cover an area of 60.8 square miles and have a total population of 121,538 (per 2010 U.S. Census).

The Court serves the cities of Berea, Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, Olmsted Falls, Olmsted Township, Strongsville, in addition to the Ohio Turnpike (Ohio State Patrol) in Strongsville, Berea, and Olmsted Township; Interstate 71 (Ohio State Patrol) in Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, and Strongsville; and the Cleveland Metropolitan Park System within the Berea Municipal Court's boundaries.

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

It is with great pleasure that we present to you the 2012 Berea Municipal Court Annual Report as required by O.R.C.§1901.14. This report is the 54<sup>th</sup> such Annual Report.

The following are highlights for the year 2012:

The Traffic / Criminal Department opened a total of 8,657 cases which consisted of 6,069 traffic cases, 1,900 misdemeanors and 684 OVI/BAC cases. Their totals represent a 25% increase over the number of citations written by local law enforcement in 2011.

The Civil Department processed 3,132 new cases consisting of 1,929 civil cases with a maximum limit of \$15,000 by statute, 605 small claims with a maximum limit of \$3,000 and 598 eviction cases. This total was slightly less than the total opened in 2011. In addition to these civil cases, the Clerk of Courts Offices processed 825 garnishment of wages and 893 bank attachments on cases previously adjudicated.

The Clerk of Courts office continued to scan closed cases, thereby eliminating the cost to store these files. We continue to work on this project to eliminate the need to store additional records offsite. Continued utilization of the Court website saw an increase of 61% in the number of waiverable citations paid online. The amount of fines and costs received of \$165,000 was a 78% increase over 2011. We continue to place additional forms on our site making it easier for parties to file various documents. Overall our site had over 150,000 visits during 2012.

In December 2012, the Clerk of Courts Office began participation with the Cuyahoga County Probate Court on a pilot program for the issuance of marriage

licenses. These licenses are issued by the Probate Court's Marriage License Bureau, when Probate Court personnel are at The Berea Municipal Court. The schedule for individuals to appear is listed on our website Courts website at <a href="https://www.bereamunicourt.org">www.bereamunicourt.org</a>.

We would like to recognize our entire staff including our Civil, Traffic / Criminal, Probation and Bailiff Departments, as well as our magistrates and acting judges, for their outstanding service in 2012. Their professionalism and dedication are truly appreciated. Grateful appreciation is also extended to the Berea Mayor Cyril Kleem, and his directors and staff; Berea City Council; Berea Police Chief Mark Schultz, and his officers and all the police departments within our Courts' jurisdiction for their assistance.

In conclusion, we will continue to operate The Berea Municipal Court in a manner truly deserving of all that utilize this Court. We will continue to monitor and evaluate all operations and expenses so that The Berea Municipal Court is operated in a fiscally responsible and business-like manner.



### 2012 COMMUNITY CONTROL DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

The Berea Municipal Court Community Control Department provides a variety of services to the court and the defendants. As directed by the Judge the Community Control Department provides presentence investigation reports. These reports are used by the court to determine the appropriate sentence, with the goal to minimize the recidivism of the defendants. The Department monitors defendant's compliance with the courts required sentence and provides assistance to offenders in obtaining services such as mental health, substance abuse, and counseling.

In addition to the supervision of defendants, the Community Control Department monitors two Diversion Programs. The DUS Diversion program assists the defendants in obtaining a valid driver's license. The First Offender program works with low risk, non-violent, first time offenders, to educate each participant on the effects of their actions and to prevent the defendant from reoffending.
