Pursuant to Section 1901.14(A)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Berea Municipal Court herewith submits its 55th Annual Report for the year 2013. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Raymond J. Wohl, the Clerk of Courts and his staff of Deputy Clerks. This report reflects the financial and statistical activity of the Court in detail with respect to all political subdivisions within the Court district.

The Berea Municipal Court has been located in the City of Berea, by an act of the Ohio Legislature, since 1958. The Court district boundaries cover an area of 60.8 square miles and have a total population of 121,538 (per 2010 U.S. Census).

The Court serves the cities of Berea, Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, Olmsted Falls, Olmsted Township, Strongsville, in addition to the Ohio Turnpike (Ohio State Patrol) in Strongsville, Berea, and Olmsted Township; Interstate 71 (Ohio State Patrol) in Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, and Strongsville; and the Cleveland Metropolitan Park System within the Berea Municipal Court's boundaries.

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

It is with great pleasure that we present to you the 2013 Berea Municipal Court Annual Report as required by O.R.C.§1901.14. This report is our 55th such Annual report.

The following are highlights for the year 2013:

The Traffic / Criminal Department opened a total of 9,169 cases which consisted of 6,687 traffic cases, 1,797 misdemeanors, 546 OVI/BAC cases and 166 felony cases. These totals represent a overall increase of 6.2% over the number of citations written by local law enforcement in 2012.

The Civil Department processed 2,697 new cases consisting of 1,595 civil cases with a maximum limit of \$15,000 by statute, 584 small claims with a maximum limit of \$3000 and 518 eviction cases. This total was slightly less than the total opened in 2012. In addition to these civil cases, the Clerk of Courts Offices processed 892 garnishment of wages and 716 bank attachments on cases preciously adjudicated.

The Clerk of Courts office continued to scan closed cases, thereby eliminating the cost to store these files. We continue to work on this project to eliminate the need to store additional records offsite. Continued utilization of the Court website, which achieved the one millionth visitor, saw an increase in the number of waiverable citations paid online. The amount of fines and costs received of \$200,500 was a 22% increase over 2012 on just under 1,100 tickets paid.

The Court has also continued the practice of holding bi-weekly hearings for individuals with unpaid fines and court costs on previously adjudicated cases. The purpose is to provide these individuals who, for financial reasons, cannot pay

their obligation to the court in full. In 2013 these hearings provided over \$225,000 in previously uncollected revenue for the Court.

We would like to recognize our entire staff including Civil, Traffic / Criminal, Probation and Bailiff Departments, as well as our magistrates and acting judges, for their outstanding services in 2013. Their professionalism and dedication are truly appreciated. Grateful appreciation is also extended to the Berea Mayor Cyril Kleem, and his directors and staff; The Berea City Council; Berea Police Chief Mark Schultz, and his officers and all the police departments within our Courts jurisdiction for their assistance.

In conclusion, we will continue to operate The Berea Municipal Court in a manner truly deserving of all that utilize this Court. We will continue to monitor and evaluate all operations and expenses so that The Berea Municipal Court is operated in a fiscally responsible and business-like manner.



2013 COMMUNITY CONTROL DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

The Berea Municipal Court Community Control Department provides a variety of services to the court and the defendants. As directed by the Judge the Community Control Department provides presentence investigation reports. These reports are used by the court to determine the appropriate sentence, with the goal to minimize the recidivism of the defendants. The Department monitors defendant's compliance with the courts required sentence and provides assistance to offenders in obtaining services such as mental health, substance abuse, and counseling.

In addition to the supervision of defendants, the Community Control Department monitors three Diversion Programs. In 2013 the Community Control Department developed The Theft Diversion Program, working with defendants charged with Petty Theft. The Theft Diversion program targets specific intervention programming to participants to prevent, eliminate, or reduce the rate of recidivism among the programs' participants and promote the collection of restitution to the victim(s). The DUS Diversion program assists the defendants in obtaining a valid driver's license. The First Offender program works with low risk, non-violent, first time offenders, to educate each participant on the effects of their actions and to prevent the defendant from reoffending.
