Pursuant to Section 1901.14(A)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Berea Municipal Court herewith submits its 59th Annual Report for the year 2017. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Raymond J. Wohl, the Clerk of Courts and his staff of Deputy Clerks. This report reflects the financial and statistical activity of the Court in detail with respect to all political subdivisions within the Court district.

The Berea Municipal Court has been located in the City of Berea, by an act of the Ohio Legislature, since 1958. The Court district boundaries cover an area of 60.8 square miles and have a total population of 121,538 (per 2010 U.S. Census).

The Court serves the cities of Berea, Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, Olmsted Falls, Olmsted Township, Strongsville, in addition to the Ohio Turnpike (Ohio State Patrol) in Strongsville, Berea, and Olmsted Township; Interstate 71 (Ohio State Patrol) in Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, and Strongsville; and the Cleveland Metropolitan Park System within the Berea Municipal Court's boundaries.

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

It is with great pleasure that we present to you the 2017 Berea Municipal Court Annual Report as required by O.R.C. §1901.14. This report is our 59th such Annual Report.

The following are highlights for the year 2017:

Our Traffic/Criminal Department opened a total of 9,137 cases which consisted of 6,423 traffic cases, 1,880 misdemeanors, 528 OVI/BAC cases and 306 felony cases. These new filings reflect a slight increase when compared to those in 2016.

The Civil Department processed 3,085 new cases consisting of 1,897 civil cases with a maximum limit of \$15,000 by statute, 686 small claims with a maximum limit of \$6,000 and 502 eviction cases. These new Civil filings represented an 18.50% increase over 2016 filings. In addition to these civil cases, the Clerk of Courts Office processed 790 garnishment of wages and 524 bank attachments on cases previously adjudicated.

Through the direction of the Clerk of Court the Berea Municipal Court was again successful with an award of a grant from the Supreme Court of Ohio. This increased the amount of grant money received through the grant process to \$94,300 during the last 3 years. The 2017 grant was directed toward the beginning of a coordinated project with the Ohio Department of Public Safety to directly received Ohio State Patrol citations electronically. Once completed, this will allow for quicker access for scheduling and adjudication.

The Court continues to face the challenge of collecting outstanding Court costs and fines from defendants with hardship for payment. Through an aggressive but

understanding and compassionate collection program, the Court collected over \$850,000 in funds owed. By conducting special biweekly hearings, overdue costs collected help keep the Court in a positive financial position.

We would like to recognize our entire staff including Civil, Traffic/Criminal, Probation and Bailiff Departments, as well as our magistrates and acting judges, for their outstanding services in 2017. Their professionalism and dedication are truly appreciated. Grateful appreciation is also extended to the Berea Mayor Cyril Kleem along with his directors and staff, the Berea City Council, Berea Police Chief Joe Grecol and his officers as well as the Law Enforcement Agencies within our Court's jurisdiction.

In conclusion, we will continue to operate The Berea Municipal Court in a manner truly deserving of all that utilize this Court. We will continue to monitor and evaluate all operations and expenses so that The Berea Municipal Court is operated in a fiscally responsible and business-like manner.

2017 COMMUNITY CONTROL DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

The Berea Municipal Court Community Control Department provides a variety of services to the court and the defendants. As directed by the Judge the Community Control Department provides presentence investigation reports. These reports are used by the court to determine the appropriate sentence, with the goal to minimize the recidivism of the defendants and protect the public. The department staff monitors defendant's compliance with the courts required sentence and assist offenders in completing these requirements.

In addition to the supervision of defendants, the Community Control Department monitors three Diversion Programs. The Theft Diversion program targets specific intervention programming to participants to prevent, eliminate, or reduce the rate of recidivism among the programs' participants and promote the collection of restitution to the victim(s). The DUS Diversion program assists the defendants in obtaining a valid driver's license. The First Offender program works with low risk, non-violent, first time offenders, to educate each participant on the effects of their actions and to prevent the defendant from reoffending.

Indigent Drivers Alcohol Treatment Fund (IDAT):

The IDAT fund provides treatment and monitoring services on a restricted basis for persons arrested for OVI offenses that are unable to afford these services. The Court is permitted to declare a surplus of the funds, once a surplus has been declared the funds are permitted to be used for defendants charged with any type of offense, where drugs or alcohol attributed to the cause of the charges against the defendant. The IDAT fund operates on the State fiscal year, with the funds coming from fees and fines collected as set per Ohio legislation.
