Pursuant to Section 1901.14(A)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Berea Municipal Court herewith submits its 64th Annual Report for the year 2022. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Raymond J. Wohl, the Clerk of Courts and his staff of Deputy Clerks. This report reflects the financial and statistical activity of the Court in detail with respect to all political subdivisions within the Court district.

The Berea Municipal Court has been located in the City of Berea, by an act of the Ohio Legislature, since 1958. The Court district boundaries cover an area of 60.8 square miles and have a total population of 122,993 (per 2020 U.S. Census).

The Court serves the cities of Berea, Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, Olmsted Falls, Olmsted Township, Strongsville, in addition to the Ohio Turnpike (Ohio State Patrol) in Strongsville, Berea, and Olmsted Township; Interstate 71 (Ohio State Patrol) in Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, and Strongsville; and the Cleveland Metropolitan Park System within the Berea Municipal Court's boundaries.

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

It is with great pleasure that we present to you the 2022 Berea Municipal Court Annual Report as required by O.R.C. §1901.14. This report is our 64th such Annual Report.

The following are highlights for the year 2022:

Our Traffic/Criminal Department opened a total of 7,687 cases, a 16% increase over 2021, consisting of 5,734 traffic cases, 1,231 misdemeanors, 394 felony cases and 328 OVI (Operating Vehicle Under the Influence).

The Civil Department processed 2,646 new cases, a 4% increase over 2021, consisting of 1,466 civil cases with a maximum limit of \$15,000 by statute, 699 small claims with a maximum limit of \$6,000 and 481 eviction cases. In addition to these civil cases, the Clerk of Courts Office processed 997 garnishment of wages and 241 bank attachments on cases previously adjudicated.

While facing the ongoing challenge of collecting outstanding Court costs and fines from defendants, the Berea Municipal Court continues its relationship with the Attorney General of Ohio (AGO) for collections. In addition to working with defendants internally who agree to payment arrangements, the Court forwards uncollectable cases to the AGO for assistance with recovery. Since beginning this partnership in late 2020 the AGO has recovered nearly \$400,000 from delinquent defendants.

We would like to recognize our entire staff including Civil, Traffic/Criminal, Probation and Bailiff Departments, as well as our Magistrates and Acting Judges, for their outstanding services in 2022. Their professionalism and dedication are

truly appreciated. Grateful appreciation is also extended to the Berea Mayor Cyril Kleem along with his Directors, staff, the Berea City Council, Berea Police Chief Dan Clark and his officers, as well as all Law Enforcement Agencies within our Court's Jurisdiction.

In conclusion, we will continue to operate The Berea Municipal Court in a manner truly deserving of all that utilize this Court. We will continue to monitor and evaluate all operations and expenses so that The Berea Municipal Court is operated in a fiscally responsible and business-like manner.

SECTION FIVE COMMUNITY CONTROL

2022 COMMUNITY CONTROL DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

The Berea Municipal Court Community Control Department provides a variety of services to the court and the offenders referred for monitoring. As directed by the Judge an offender may be referred for pre-sentence investigation reports, these reports are used by the court to determine the appropriate sentence, with the goal to minimize the recidivism of the offender and protect the public. The department staff monitors offender's compliance with the courts required sentence and aid offenders in completing these requirements. In addition to the monitoring of sentenced offenders the Community Control Departments monitors the bond conditions of high- risk offenders with the use of; Continuous Alcohol Monitoring Device (CAM), Global Position Tracking Device (GPS) and Pre-Trial Supervision.

The Community Control Department staff oversee four Diversion Programs. The Substance Abuse Intervention In lieu of Conviction Program (SA/ILC), this program targets offenders in need of substance abuse treatment when their use of drugs and/or alcohol were the primary contributing factor that led to the charge(s). The Theft Diversion program targets specific intervention programming to participants to prevent, eliminate, or reduce the rate of recidivism among the programs' participants and promote the collection of restitution to the victim(s). The DUS Diversion program assists the defendants in obtaining a valid driver's license. The First Offender program works with low risk, non-violent, first-time offenders, to educate each participant on the effects of their actions and to prevent the defendant from reoffending.
